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Projek rintis Badan Pendamai LPPKN buka lembaran baharu tangani krisis perkahwinan

KUALA LUMPUR: Kerajaan melancarkan Projek Rintis Badan Pendamai Lembaga Penduduk dan Pembangunan Keluarga Negara (LPPKN) dengan kerjasama strategik Jabatan Pendaftaran Negara (JPN).

Projek ini adalah satu inisiatif bersepadu untuk mengurus krisis perkahwinan dan perceraian bagi pasangan bukan Islam secara lebih efektif.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, berkata hingga September lalu, projek rintis itu yang dilaksanakan di Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur itu menunjukkan keberkesanan ketara apabila kadar pendamai meningkat kepada 16 peratus berbanding hanya dua peratus sebelum ini.

Projek itu diwujudkan hasil keprihatinan terhadap isu berkenaan dengan memperkenalkan model intervensi keluarga bersepadu yang menggabungkan prosiding tribunal dan sesi kaunseling dalam satu ekosistem sokongan profesional dan menyeluruh.

"Melalui projek ini, tiga fungsi utama akan dilaksanakan, antaranya menjadi ruang praperundangan bagi membantu pasangan mencari penyelesaian sebelum kes difailkan di mahkamah.

"Selain itu, menyediakan platform kaunseling serta konferens keluarga yang kondusif, serta memperkasa perkhidmatan sosial berasaskan data serta penyelidikan melalui lima geran bernilai RM240,000.

"Kerjasama ini signifikan kerana menyatukan kepakaran dua kementerian, Kementerian Dalam Negeri (KDN) yang menguruskan pendaftaran perkahwinan dan perceraian bukan Islam, serta KPWK yang memperkukuh institusi keluarga dan menyediakan intervensi sosial," katanya berucap pada Majlis menandatangani memorandum persefahaman (MoU) projek itu di sini, hari ini.

Hadir sama Menteri Dalam Negeri, Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution.

Terdahulu, Memorandum Persefahaman antara JPM di bawah KDN dan LPPKN di bawah KPWK dimeterai.

Sementara itu, Saifuddin menyifatkan pemeteraian MOU itu dilakukan tepat pada masanya.

Berdasarkan impak positif yang dicapai, katanya program akan diperluaskan kepada beberapa negeri lain dalam tempoh tiga tahun akan datang.

"Melihat kepada kejayaan projek rintis yang sudah dilaksanakan sebelum ini, kita yakin bahawa usaha ini perlu diteruskan dan diperluaskan.

"Bermula di Kuala Lumpur, projek rintis ini membabitkan 83 pasangan. Melalui pendekatan baharu yang kita perkenalkan, kadar kejayaan pendamai meningkat kepada 16 peratus berbanding hanya dua peratus di bawah JPN.

"Kita mengenal pasti lima bidang utama kerjasama, termasuk aspek pendidikan, pembangunan, dan yang paling penting, kita akan mewartakan peranan LPPKN seperti yang termaktub di bawah Akta Membaharu Undang-Undang (Perkahwinan dan Perceraian) 1976," katanya.

Melalui MoU itu juga, katanya, LPPKN akan membangunkan satu model atau garis panduan standard bagi proses pendamai, yang akan dijadikan rujukan utama kepada agensi-agensi lain.

"Saya percaya langkah ini menunjukkan bahawa kita sedang bergerak di atas landasan yang betul, selaras dengan komitmen kerajaan untuk memperkukuh institusi kekeluargaan dan menyokong kesejahteraan rakyat secara menyeluruh," katanya.

Setakat ini, LPPKN mempunyai 60 pegawai kaunselor bertauliah bagi melaksanakan tugas pendamai di seluruh negara.

Students more comfortable with external counsellors

➤ Outreach efforts reveal need for early emotional intervention and parental involvement: Minister

KUALA LUMPUR: Students are more likely to seek emotional support from external counsellors than from those in their own schools due to fear of disciplinary action, said Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

She said outreach programmes have revealed that many students only open up when speaking to counsellors brought in from outside, pointing to a serious trust deficit within school counselling systems.

"During the *Gali Potensi Diri* programmes, students open up to external counsellors. They are afraid that if they speak to counsellors in their schools, action would be taken against them.

"This tells us that there are issues of trust we need to address," she said during the closing ceremony of National Counselling Month yesterday.

Nancy said the ministry's outreach efforts have uncovered troubling signs, including students as young as 13 engaging in sexual relationships, underscoring the need for early emotional intervention and parental involvement.

"This is not about blaming parents. Parenting today is incredibly challenging.

"But we cannot assume our children are too young to be exposed or affected. We must be present and attentive.

"If they do not have a safe channel to talk, they will look for answers elsewhere. That is when risky behaviour or unhealthy online influences could take over."

She warned that the growing demand for emotional and psychological support has led to a rise in unqualified individuals offering counselling services, putting public safety and professionalism at risk.

Nancy stressed that only counsellors registered with the Malaysian Board of Counsellors are legally recognised to practise, particularly when cases involve the courts.

"If someone claiming to be a counsellor is called to court, the judge would ask: 'Where is your proof of professionalism?'"

"Being trained to guide or handle people at work is not the same as being a registered counsellor.

"If you are practising counselling, make sure you are registered."

As of August, Malaysia had 12,583 registered counsellors, which is insufficient given the surge in mental health concerns, she said.

She cited Health Ministry data showing that one in three Malaysians experiences anxiety or depression, while police recorded over 1,100 suicide cases in 2021, a sharp rise from previous years.

Domestic violence cases also exceeded 7,000 reports in 2024.

Nancy cautioned against over-reliance on digital tools and artificial intelligence (AI) for mental health support.

"We must remember that AI is artificial. We are natural intelligence. Technology can assist, but it cannot replace human empathy.

"A counsellor needs a heart, feelings and emotional presence. A machine cannot provide that."

She reiterated that counselling services must remain ethical and accessible, particularly for rural and low-income communities, and urged those in need to contact Talian Kasih 15999 for immediate help.

Kaunselor terlatih termasuk sukarelawan wajib berdaftar dengan LKM: Nancy

KUALA LUMPUR: Semua kaunselor terlatih termasuk sukarelawan wajib berdaftar dengan Lembaga Kaunselor Malaysia (LKM) sebelum menawarkan perkhidmatan kaunseling, kata Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat Dato Sri Nancy Shukri.

Beliau berkata, Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK) dan LKM membuat ketetapan itu supaya kaunseling diberikan lebih inklusif serta berimpak tinggi khususnya bagi golongan rentan dan luar bandar.

Nancy berkata, sehingga Ogos lalu, terdapat 12,583 kaunselor berdaftar di Malaysia.

"Melalui Dasar dan Pelan Tindakan Perkhidmatan Kaunseling Negara 2025-2035 yang sedang digubal, LKM tekad memastikan profesion ini kekal relevan, beretika dan berpaksikan nilai kemanusiaan," katanya ketika berucap dalam majlis perasmian penutupan Sambutan Bulan Kaunseling Kebangsaan 2025 di sini, semalam.

Kaunselor terlatih termasuk sukarelawan wajib berdaftar dengan LKM: Nancy

Nancy berkata, KPWK komited memperkukuh peranan Sukarelawan Kaunselor Berdaftar (SKB) sebagai wira lapangan yang menyantuni masyarakat melalui Talian Kasih 15999 dan pelbagai program komuniti.

Selain itu, Nancy berkata sehingga September lepas, lebih 9,700 kes berjaya ditangan ter- masuk bantuan awal psikologi kepada mangsa kemalangan melibatkan penuntut Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (UPSI) pada Jun lepas, yang mencerminkan nilai sebenar empati dan kemanusiaan.

"Melalui kempen Awak OK Tak? Jom Kongsi! kita juga mengajak rakyat Malaysia lebih terbuka berkongsi perasaan.

"Kadang-kadang, satu soalan kecil boleh memberi harapan besar kepada seseorang yang sedang bergelut. 'Awak OK Tak?' bukan sekadar pertanyaan, tetapi tanda kita peduli (dan) mereka tidak berseorangan," katanya.

Sementara itu, Presiden LKM Datin Dr Ruhani Mat Min berkata pihaknya telah melancarkan

portal MyeLKM iaitu pangkalan data mengenai kaunselor berdaftar dengan LKM.

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MALAYSIA JOINS WEF TO CHAMPION GENDER EQUALITY AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT

MALAYSIA has become the first Asean nation to join the World Economic Forum (WEF)'s Global Gender Parity Accelerator Network, underscoring its dedication to advancing women's economic participation.

The network is a public-private collaboration platform operating across more than 35 countries and regions. It serves as a bridge between governments and businesses to collectively tackle some of today's most significant economic and social issues.

Malaysia now joins countries such as Japan, Chile, Colombia, Egypt and Mexico that have leveraged this platform to advance wide-ranging policy reforms.

These include introducing gender pay gap reporting systems, extending parental and paternity leave, and creating return-to-work initiatives for women, all of which demonstrate how inclusive and sustainable growth can be achieved through shared commitment.

WEF has commended the Malaysia government for its continuous efforts in skills development and in promoting gender equality and inclusion.

WEF Asia Pacific Community lead and country manager (Malaysia) Shaun Adam said: "The World Economic Forum stands ready to support the Government of Malaysia and all its partners by connecting this effort to our regional and global networks and by sharing best practices and co-designing pathways that make gender parity a competitive advantage for Malaysia's economy."

He acknowledged Human Resources Minister Steven Sim Chee Keong's leadership in the International Labour Organization visit on Oct 22 for the Global Skills Forum (GSF), and his role at the job constituents meetings.

"He has constantly championed upskilling and lifelong learning, regardless of gender as a national priority through the My Mahir ecosystem, while balancing progress with the Gig Workers Law that was recently launched this year," praised Adam.

WEF, he noted, has a good partnership with TalentCorp, which had recently attended WEF's annual meeting in Dubai and shared some of the best practices with the international community.

"Equality is not inevitable, it happens because people choose to make it happen," he said.

Building on the country's entry to the Global Gender Parity Accelerator Network, Human Resources Ministry (Kesuma) has launched the Wanita MyWira Accelerator, a national initiative designed to equip at least 100,000 women with high-growth, future-ready skills and opportunities beyond 2030.

Spearheaded by Kesuma through its strategic think-tank agency, Talent Corporation Malaysia Bhd (TalentCorp), in partnership with the World Economic Forum (WEF), the programme will train 1,000 women under TalentCorp's MyMahir-certified pathways, targeting an 80% job placement rate within six months of completion.

Supported by a RM15mil co-investment model, this phase brings together 1,000 companies committed to adopting flexible work practices, offering retainerhip opportunities for women who have taken career breaks, and hiring trained women graduates.

In the long term, the initiative aims to empower more than 100,000 women beyond 2030, contributing to Malaysia's goal of increasing female labour force participation and building an inclusive, future-ready workforce.

Speaking at the launch of the programme, Sim said the initiative reflects the nation's commitment to both ambition and inclusion.

He noted that his Ministry, through TalentCorp, is equipping Malaysian women for future-ready and high-growth sectors such as artificial intelligence (AI) and renewable energy.

Sim added that Kesuma has introduced several policies to support working families, including the right to Flexible Work Arrangements (FWA), tax deductions of up to RM500,000 for employers who adopt FWA, and a 50% tax deduction for paid caregiving leave.

Budget 2026 also expanded childcare tax relief to cover children aged six to 12.

"Think about gender barriers as a powerful spring - coiled very tightly, built into our homes, our culture and even our own personal psyche," he said.

"Our efforts, policies and activism are forces we are applying to hold that spring back.

"But if we release that pressure, even for a moment, the spring will stubbornly bounce back and things will return to business as usual."

He noted that although Malaysia is only slightly off its goal of 60% female labour force participation, this still means that for every 10 men working, only about seven women are working.

"Through the Wanita MyWira Accelerator, the government aims to remove barriers to women's participation in the workforce by offering training for flexible job opportunities, promoting family and caregiving-friendly workplaces, and boosting women's workforce participation, especially in rural areas," Sim said.

Meanwhile, Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said the initiative reflects Malaysia's belief that when women succeed, the nation succeeds.

"Gender inequality remains a global concern, including here in Malaysia.

"As societies evolve, so too must our approach to empowering women in education, health and the economy. Because when women rise, the nation rises. Real progress demands targeted action, strong institutions and inclusive budgeting," she said.

"Through Wanita MyWira, we are creating real pathways for women to access decent work and participate fully in Malaysia's economy. This effort strengthens our national ecosystem for women's empowerment, in line with the National Policy for Women 2025-2030 and the Madani vision of compassion and shared prosperity."

Malaysia's female labour force participation rate stands at 56.5%, below the national target of 60% by 2030, and slightly higher than the Asean average of 55%.

WEF's Global Gender Gap Report 2025 ranked Malaysia 108th out of 146 countries, showing improvement from the previous year but highlighting the need for stronger action to close gender gaps in economic participation.

To help narrow this gap, the Wanita MyWira Accelerator will provide targeted training, foster employer partnerships and promote childcare-friendly practices designed to make workforce participation more accessible for women.

The strategic direction of the programme will be guided by co-chairs Sim and Nancy on behalf of the public sector.

Representing the private sector are Tunku Besar Seri Menanti and Teach For Malaysia chairman and founding trustee Tunku Ali Redhaudin Ibrni Tuanku Muhriz, BigPay group chief executive officer Aireen Omar, Microsoft Corporation legal, government and corporate affairs director (Asean and new markets) Dr Jasmine Begum, PwC Malaysia executive chair Nurul Akin Abdul Latif and LeadWomen founder and chairperson Anne Abraham.

The implementation of the initiative will be led by TalentCorp, with support from the respective ministries and WEF.

'1,183 cases of domestic violence involving male victims'

A TOTAL of 1,183 cases of domestic violence involving male victims were recorded up to July this year, the Dewan Rakyat heard yesterday.

Deputy Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Noraini Ahmad said police data showed that men were not exempt from becoming victims of domestic violence.

"The government, through the National Population and Family

Development Board (LPPKN), is implementing a strategic initiative in line with the 13th Malaysia Plan to strengthen family institutions and enhance the quality of the nation's human capital.

"The initiative is known as the Gentlemen of the Nation programme, which includes the development and implementation of the gentlemen education module.

"The programme directly supports the board's mandate to em-

power men in their roles as husbands, fathers and responsible members of society," she said during the oral question-and-answer session in the Dewan Rakyat.

She was responding to Dr Ahmad Fakhruddin Fakhruddin (PN-Kuala Kedah), who asked about detailed statistics on male victims of domestic violence from 2022 until now.

Noraini said 1,778 male victims were recorded in 2022. The num-

ber dropped to 1,213 cases in 2023, but rose again in 2024 to 1,865 cases.

On the effectiveness of family development programmes organised by the board up to the second quarter of this year, she said findings showed positive outcomes, with over 90 per cent of participants reporting improved knowledge.

Nearly 90 per cent of participants said they had applied the

knowledge gained, while about 70 per cent experienced positive behavioural changes.

"Overall, these indicators show that modules such as Parenting@Work and other LPPKN family development programmes have had a positive impact in improving family literacy.

"They also help foster mutual respect between partners, which in turn reduces the risk of abuse, including against men."

Over 6,000 male domestic violence cases in four years

THERE were more than 6,000 cases of men being victims of domestic violence or abuse in the last four years, the Dewan Rakyat was told.

Deputy Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Dr Noraini Ahmad said police statistics showed that men were also victims of domestic violence.

"In 2022, a total of 1,778 male victims in abuse cases were recorded. The number dropped to 1,213 cases in 2023, but it rose again to 1,865 cases last year.

"As of July 2025 alone, 1,183 cases of domestic violence involv-

ing men were reported," she said.

She was replying to Dr Ahmad Fakhruddin Fakhruddin (PN-Kuala Kedah) who wanted to know the evaluation indicators for measuring the effectiveness of modules, such as the Parenting at Work module and family development programmes by National Population and Family Development Board (LPPKN) in reducing the risk of abuse against men.

Ahmad Fakhruddin also wanted to know statistics of male victims of domestic violence cases from 2022 onwards.

Noraini said that the government, through LPPKN, is imple-

menting an initiative in line with the 13th Malaysia Plan to strengthen family institutions and enhance the nation's human capital.

The initiative titled Program Lelaki Budiman Negara (National Gentleman Programme), she said, involved the development and implementation of an educational module aimed at empowering men to become responsible husbands, fathers and members of society.

This move directly support LPPKN's mandate to strengthen the role of men in the family and community.

Noraini also said there are still

male victims who still refuse to come forward due to shame or fear.

"All of us must show greater empathy and avoid being judgemental. That is why LPPKN is always improving its outreach programmes, including counselling services where victims can choose whether to speak with a male or female counsellor.

"For men, it is often better to engage with a male counsellor, allowing them to interact more comfortably and share their problems openly," she said.

Noraini also emphasised that awareness campaigns on domes-

tic violence by the ministry are inclusive in nature, seeing that it affects both men and women.

"We should not wait for them to come to us, we must reach out to them. The e-Kasih helpline is 151 599.

"What matters most is ensuring that whoever they are, the ministry will make sure they are safe. I wish to stress that domestic violence is not solely a women's issue. It is a humanitarian issue.

"A man's tears may rarely be seen, but the wounds in his heart can sometimes be very deep. Indeed, suffering knows no gender," she said.

KUALA LUMPUR – Polis merekodkan sebanyak 1,183 kes keganasan rumah tangga melibatkan mangsa lelaki berlaku sepanjang tujuh bulan pertama tahun ini.

Timbalan Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Noraini Ahmad berkata, menerusi data tersebut, lelaki juga tidak terkecuali daripada menjadi mangsa keganasan rumah tangga.

Justeru kata beliau, bagi mengatasi isu berkenaan kerajaan melalui Lembaga Penduduk dan Pembangunan Keluarga Negara (LPPKN) sedang giat melaksanakan satu inisiatif strategik selaras dengan fokus Rancangan Malaysia Ke-13 (RMK13) untuk memperkukuh institusi kekeluargaan dan meningkatkan kualiti modal insan negara.

“Inisiatif ini ialah Program Lelaki Budiman Negara yang mengandungi pembangunan dan pelaksanaan Modul Pendidikan Lelaki Budiman, yang secara langsung menyokong mandat LPPKN dalam memperkasa peranan lelaki sebagai suami, bapa dan anggota masyarakat yang bertanggungjawab,” katanya di Dewan Rakyat hari ini.

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Prioritise own well-being before helping clients, board advises counsellors

KUALA LUMPUR: Counsellors must prioritise their own physical, emotional and spiritual well-being, as well as emotional stability, before helping clients achieve a balanced and fulfilling life, says Datin Dr Ruhani Mat Min.

The Board of Counsellors Malaysia (LKM) president said that in the digital era, counsellors need to possess positive attitudes and personalities, in addition to relevant knowledge and skills, to enhance their professional competency levels.

"A 2025 scoping review study found that the two main elements of counsellor competency are attitude and personality, while knowledge and skills complement the effectiveness of counselling services.

"We cannot help others if we do not help ourselves. How can we guide our clients towards improvement if we are not in a good state ourselves?" she said.

Ruhani said this when delivering her keynote address titled "Counselling in the Digital Era: Nurturing Emotions, Enriching Humanity" at the closing ceremony of the National Counselling Month 2025 celebration here Thursday (Oct 30). The event was officiated by Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

Ruhani said counselling supervision is an important check-and-balance process to ensure the counsellor's emotional well-being, which in turn ensures the effectiveness of interventions for clients.

As such, she suggested that supervision practices be extended to certified counsellors and not be limited to university students, as the process can help strengthen emotional resilience, ethics and professionalism among counsellors.

On current challenges, Ruhani said the advancement of communication technology requires counsellors to be more aware of client data security, digital literacy gaps and information authenticity, as borderless social networks expose them to risks of data breaches and misrepresentation of professional identity.

She said data from the 2023 National Health and Welfare Survey revealed that about one million Malaysians, or 4.6% of those aged 16 and above, suffer from depression, with the youth group (aged 16-29) being the most affected due to the rise in bullying, rape and violence in schools.

"This situation demands that counsellors play a greater role in strengthening counselling services, not only for clients but also for themselves," she said.

Ruhani also encouraged counsellors to use social media platforms to spread positive emotions, build networks and strengthen human connections, while stressing that physical interaction remains vital for maintaining honesty and empathy.

"Use digital spaces creatively, but never neglect face-to-face interactions, for it is through them that empathy and sincerity are born," she added. - Bernama

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Public urged to coordinate with Social Welfare Department before sending flood aid

PUCHONG: Members of the public are encouraged to coordinate with Social Welfare Department officers at temporary relief centres before sending aid to flood victims, says director-general Datuk Che Murad Sayang Ramjan.

Addressing claims that the department rejects public aid, Che Murad Sayang said there is a standard operating procedure for aid distribution.

"Malaysians are a generous bunch. But there are instances where people just come and give aid without knowing how much is needed.

"For example, if there are 600 victims at a centre and only 300 sets of aid are given, should we distribute it? Those who receive the aid are happy, but those who do not will be disappointed, and our officers end up facing criticism from both victims and the public.

"Our officers are on the receiving end of criticism in such situations," he said during a media briefing on preparations for the upcoming northeast monsoon season here on Thursday (Oct 30).

He also urged residents in flood-prone areas to register themselves and their family members on the MyIBJKM application to locate the nearest evacuation centres.

"Its use can also make the Bantuan Wang Ihsan aid application easier. Previously, it was a multi-layered process, but now, those registered can be directly submitted to the National Disaster Management Agency for payouts," he said.

The northeast monsoon is expected to begin in November and last until March next year.

According to the Malaysian Meteorological Department, five to seven episodes of heavy continuous downpour are expected, and a weak La Nina has also been forecast during this period.

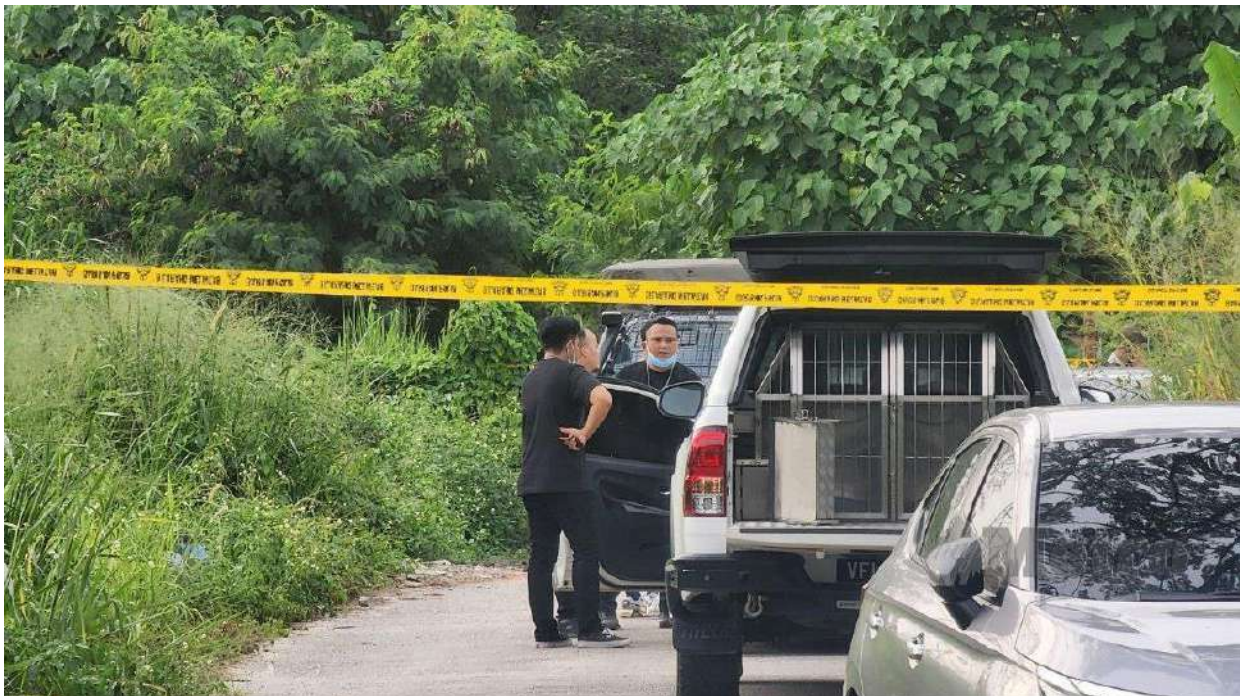

Body found in parked car at mall that of missing woman, cops confirm

KUCHING: Police have confirmed that the body found inside a car parked at a shopping mall along Jalan Song here on Wednesday was that of a woman reported missing several days ago.

Kuching police chief ACP Alexson Naga Chabu said police received a report at 1.55pm from a member of the public who found an unconscious woman inside a vehicle at the mall's parking area.

He said a team was dispatched to the scene to verify the report and found the woman lying in the driver's seat.

"Firefighters from the Tabuan Jaya fire station were called to assist in opening the vehicle, which was locked from the inside.

The woman was later confirmed dead by medical personnel from Sarawak General

Hospital," he said in a statement yesterday.

Alexson said the deceased, in her 20s, was identified as the woman who had been reported missing in the Tabuan Jaya area on Oct 25.

Her body has been sent to Sarawak General Hospital for a post-mortem.

"Initial investigations at the scene found no criminal elements, and the case has been classified as sudden death," he added.

Police have urged the public not to speculate on the incident out of respect for the victim's family.

Alexson dalam masa sama menasihati orang ramai agar tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi berhubung kejadian itu bagi menjaga sensitiviti keluarga mangsa.
