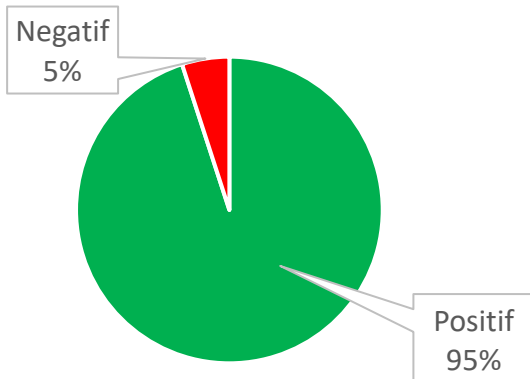

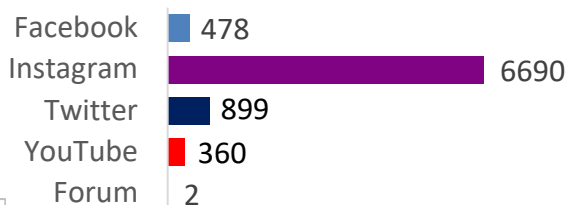

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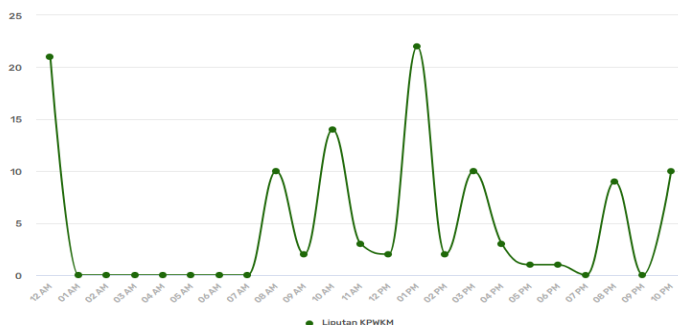

Govt mulls national registry for domestic violence offenders

The government is studying the establishment of a national Domestic Violence Offender Registry to track repeat offenders and strengthen protection for women and children.

"The proposed registry is aimed at strengthening prevention, enforcement and protection efforts for domestic violence," she said.

"At the same time, the proposed must carefully balance legal, ethical and human rights considerations," she said in a written parliamentary reply.

Nancy was responding to questions from the police and the courts.

She added for updates on the formation of a national Domestic Violence Offender Registry and the government's monitoring and enforcement mechanisms involving the police, the Social Welfare Department, government hospitals and clinics, and non-governmental organisations.

Nancy said the ministry remained committed to addressing domestic violence through a whole-of-government and whole-of-society approach focusing on prevention, protection, intervention and rehabilitation.

Nancy added that the Domestic Violence Committee would continue to coordinate, monitor and discuss policies, programmes and initiatives among relevant agencies to improve the national response to domestic violence.

"She also said the ministry would continue reviewing and strengthening standard operating procedures and related service delivery to ensure complaint channels and victim protection systems remained responsive, effective and aligned with current needs and challenges."
